THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Noah stood out in sharp contrast to the sin all around him. How do you think he fit in with his neighbors and relatives?

Building the ark was one huge labor intensive project. It required a lot of lumber from many trees. How long do you think it took to build it?

Note that Noah did all that God commanded him (v 22). As Noah “walked with God” (v 9), he was enabled to accomplish an otherwise impossible task. What do you know in your heart that you should be doing for the LORD but are putting it off? The LORD’S commands and revealed will also provide the power to perform!
